## This Month's Priorities

---

1. **GPRO:** Our 2020 GPRO reporting is in full swing. Brian and his team will be reaching out for assistance with gathering the data we need to successfully report for Medicare's Shared Savings Program/MIPS, which directly affects our FFS payments. The practice teams have been great and we ask for continued cooperation as we work through this tight timeframe.
  2. **MIPS APM Promoting Interoperability Reporting:** During the January 4th-March 31st reporting period **each practice (TIN) must report** their Promoting Interoperability(PI) data directly to CMS utilizing their [QPP Portal Account](#) as part of their ACO participation for 2020. [James Renner](#) has been working with your teams to review reporting and/or hardship applications as appropriate. You will select your best 90 day consecutive reporting period from 2020 to report.
  3. **QRDA 3 EMR Quality Reports:** Beginning in 2021 and mandated in 2022 ACOs will need to adjust how we report our quality metrics. In preparation for this change we are asking that all practices run a QRDA3 report from their EMR for 2020. Once you have done this please notify [Brian Pinga](#) and he will work with you to set up a review of the report and/or provide additional guidance as needed.

## CMS Billing Update

---

### REMINDER: Medicare FFS Claims: 2% added back to the bottom line!

Since 2013 CMS has applied a 2% reduction (know as sequestration) to all Medicare FFS (fee for service) claims. The two acts passed by Congress over the past year (CARES and the Consolidated Appropriations Act) suspended this 2% reduction from May 1, 2020 until March 31, 2021 therefore adding 2% back to the bottom line of your Medicare FFS claims. **CCD=Clinical Condition Documentation** – this program focuses on the complete and accurate documentation of our patient's current and chronic conditions, including assignment of the most specific ICD 10 (HCC) codes . With complete and accurate documentation, we are able to reflect the quality and complexity of care we are providing our patients.

**Eileen Jones R.N, BSN, MSHA, CRC is our new director of Clinical Condition Documentation.** Eileen along with Dr. Matthew Miles, CMO, look forward to working with you to support this very important work. They want to understand how they can best support you with your documentation and ICD 10

(HCC) coding initiatives.

To begin the education on Clinical Condition Documentation – a webinar titled **Clinical Condition Document (CCD) Provider Education** will be held on **February 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:00PM to 7:00PM ET**. The objectives for the education session are:

- Discuss how achieving complete and accurate CCD requires reflecting the patient's clinical status as accurately as possible
- Discuss how medical record documentation must support HCC coding for purposed of compliance and clinical accuracy
- Discuss the need to consider risk adjustment at all appropriate visit for the purpose of annual re-validating relevant diagnosis

### Medicare Wellness Visits: Get Your Patients Off to a Healthy Start

Medicare covers wellness visits, and your patients pay nothing if you accept assignment. Recommend the Initial Preventive Physical Examination (IPPE) and Annual Wellness Visit (AWV) to get your patients off to a healthy start this year.

The IPPE or the “Welcome to Medicare” preventive visit is a one-time visit for newly-enrolled patients:

- Review medical and social health history
- Discuss preventive services

The AWV or “Yearly Wellness Visit” focuses on preventive health:

- Develop or update a personalized prevention plan
- Perform a health risk assessment
