Diagnosed Infection/Sepsis

Every Day	 Because you have an infection, you are at risk for sepsis. Sepsis is your body's severe response to an infection. It is a life-threatening condition. Watch for fever or feeling chilled, confusion, sleepiness, fast heart rate, fast breathing or shortness of breath, extreme pain, or pale/discolored skin.
Green Zone	 ALL CLEAR! This zone is your goal. Your symptoms are under control. No fever or feeling chilled No fast heart rate No confusion or sleepiness Easy breathing No increase in pain
Yellow Zone	Call your home care nurse at
Red Zone	EMERGENCY Zone!! Call 911 or have someone take you to the Emergency Room! Temperature is 101°F (38.3°C) or greater, or below 96.8°F (36°C), or you have shaking chills Heart rate is greater than 90 beats per minute Respiratory rate is greater than 20 breaths per minute Confusion or a change in mental status Decrease in urine output Shortness of breath or becoming harder to breathe Abdominal pain
